Get a physician to examine you at the first signs of recurring knee problems. There are a range of treatment options available to help manage symptoms associated with knee OA. Common modalities include increasing moderate physical activity, weight loss, physical therapy and medication.

Knee braces and other supportive devices such as cushioning gel insoles help relieve pain and provide joint stability. Injections (visco-supplementation) are commonly used for more severe knee OA. Surgery may be required if other treatment options don't succeed.
